

REGION IV: THE MOTHER REGION

- First Society of Black Engineers chapter formed by 6 Black men studying engineering (known as the Chicago Six) at Purdue University in 1974
- First official convention held at Purdue in **1975** with 48 students from 32 schools – unanimously voted to officially form the **"National Society of Black Engineers**"
