WHAT IS NSBE?

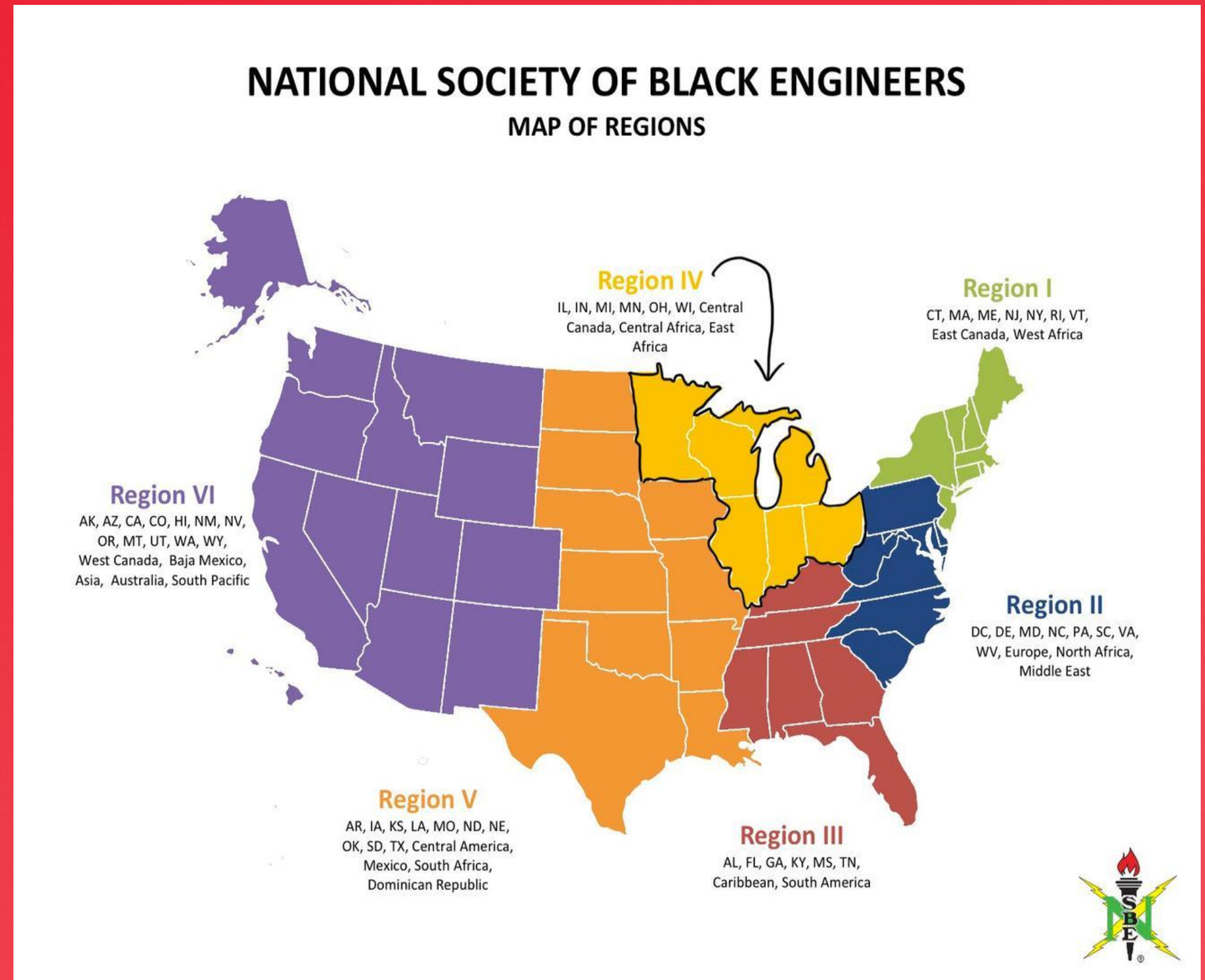
NSBE stands for the “National Society of Black Engineers”

REGION IV: THE MOTHER REGION

- First Society of Black Engineers chapter formed by 6 Black men studying engineering (**known as the Chicago Six**) at Purdue University in 1974
- First official convention held at Purdue in **1975** with 48 students from 32 schools – **unanimously voted to officially form the “National Society of Black Engineers”**

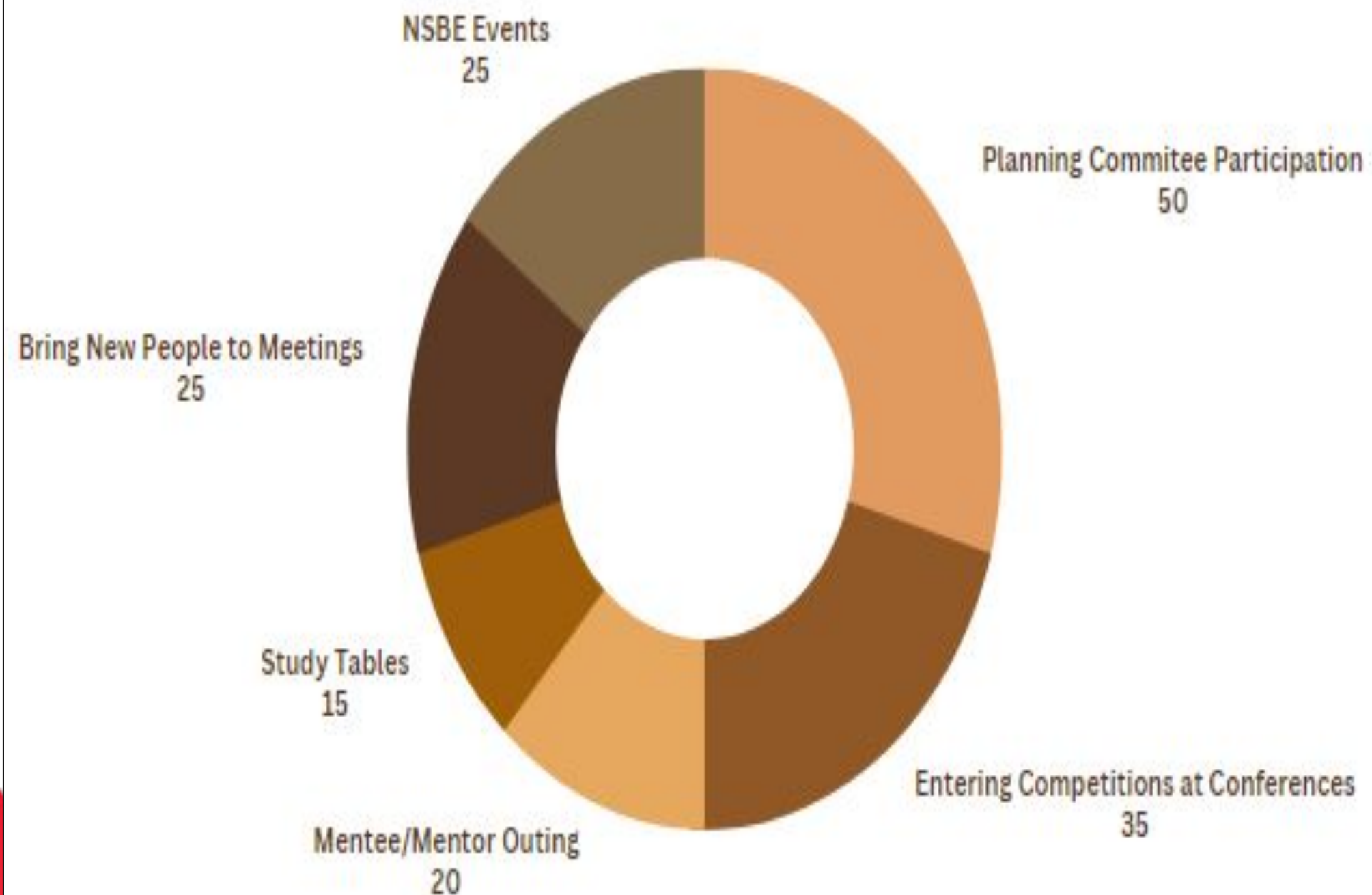

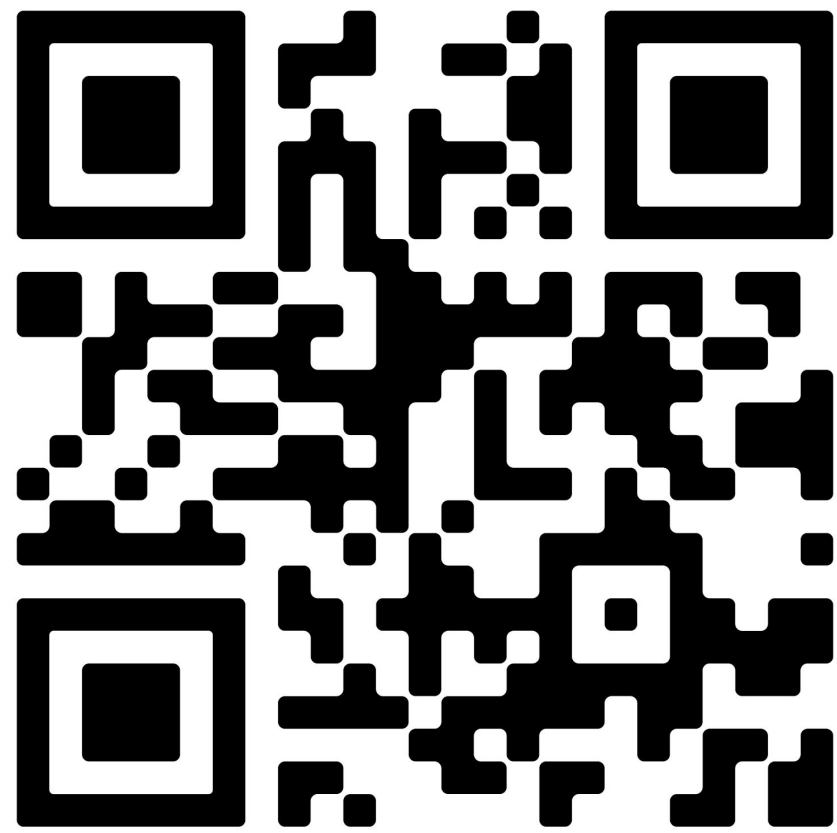
